Please accept this letter as confirmation that the University of Strathclyde recognises the International Arab Baccalaureate. We are satisfied that this meets the academic level required for direct entry to our undergraduate degree programmes.

There are subject specific requirements for individual programmes with students often required to achieve a minimum score in specific subjects. Each application will be considered in full by the academic department. However, the general base requirements for each of our faculties are listed below:

Faculty of Science

- 84% - Year 1 Entry
- 90% - Year 2 Entry (MPharm Year 2 – 93%)

Faculty of Engineering

- 84% - Year 1 Entry
- 90% - Year 2 Entry

Humanities and Social Sciences

- 84% - Year 1 Entry
- 90% - Year 2 Entry

Strathclyde Business School

- Year 1 Entry Only – 84%

Please note - second year entry is only available on specified courses, more detail is available on our website.

English Language Requirements;

- IELTS (Academic): 6.5 overall (no individual band less than 5.5)

- Faculty of Science: IELTS (Academic): 6.0 overall (no individual band less than 5.5)

There are some variations to these requirements for specific programmes. Please check each individual course page for details.

Acceptance of the IAB will be reviewed periodically by the Admissions and the International Recruitment Teams at the University.
